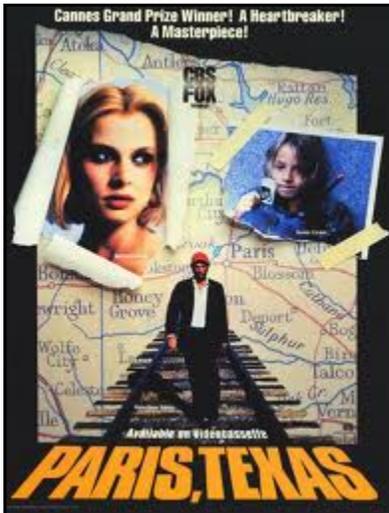


PARIS, TEXAS
