8.BELFAST


The capital of Northern Ireland and it is part of the United Kingdom.

TIE can be taken by junior and adult students on either short or long courses in Ireland as well as abroad.

The Progressive College Network is newly formed organisation to meet the demand for an alternate representative body for the private college community in Ireland.



Enrolled Learner Protection

NED Training Centre has approval to offer students learner protection insurance, Learner Protection insurance is only in place when each student receives their certificate.

In line with current national regulations; all students enrolled on courses 3 months or longer in duration, are obliged to purchase Learner Protection Insurance as part of their course fees. This is an insurance that protects the student's fees.

OF ELIGIBLE PROGRAMMES (ILEP)

The Irish Government has approved new rules about English language schools for non-European students and their Visas. The new measures came into force in January 2014.

The final part of this is the introduction of an Interim List of Eligible Programmes (ILEP) which was implemented by the Department of Justice and Equality in January 20th 2016. From now on, only schools that are on the list will be able to receive Non-European students for long term courses.

NED Training Centre is on the new Interim list of schools. NED Training Centre has always worked hard to assure top quality education and full compliance with Government regulations. We continue to operate a high quality institution and meet all criteria and requirements.

It proves you can use everyday written and spoken English for work or study purposes. It has global recognition and it is the perfect opportunity to get a certification that attests to your level of English for your entire life.





TOEFL

The TOEFL® test is the most widely respected English-language test in the world, recognised by more than 9,000 colleges, universities and agencies in more than 130 countries, including Australia, Canada, the U.K. and the United States. In the test there are four sections (listening, reading, speaking and writing) which take a total of about four and a half hours to complete.



<u>IELTS</u>



IELTS is the International English Language Testing System and it is accepted as evidence of English language proficiency by over 9,000 organisations worldwide. These include universities, immigration departments, government agencies, professional bodies and multinational companies.
